



NOTES:

1. A Residential Driveway is one that serves a dwelling or dwellings used by two (2) families or less.
2. Driveway width is measured between points at bottom of depressed curb.
3. Distance between driveways is measured between points at top of curb.
4. Where curb is not existing, the curb line and grade shall be staked by the City Engineer.
5. Existing Drive Entrance Depressions Not Being Used As Access To Property Shall Be Removed And Replaced With Curb, Gutter And Sidewalk Per City Standards.
6. Minimum distance between driveways on a common parcel shall be 20'.
